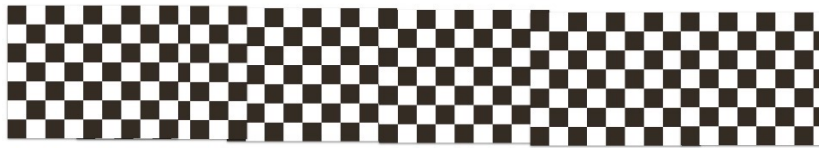

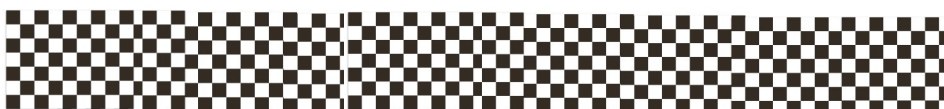
Welcome to the May 2026 edition of the MG Car Club Malta Rev'd UP Bulletin!

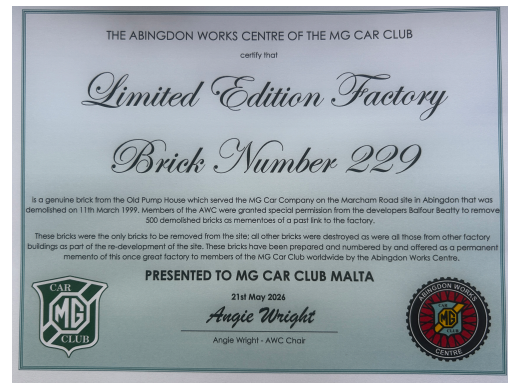

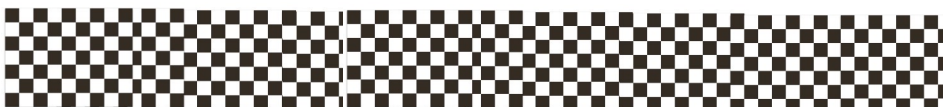

Our participants were treated to a warm welcome with complimentary coffee, and to top it all off, each participant was presented with a special goodies bag as a token of appreciation for joining the event.



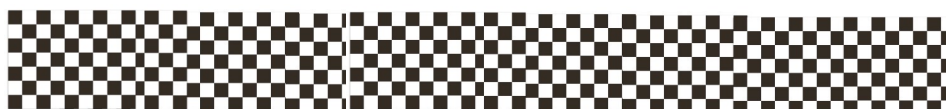

A Showcase of Passion and Polish

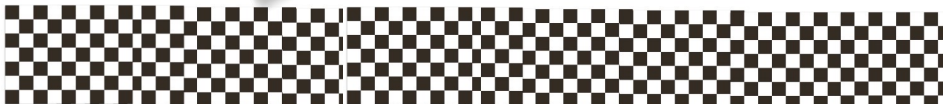
